

Our small organization stays pretty busy, with adoptions and MORE. In 2022, our community outreach expanded. In addition to 71 dog adoptions and 154(!) cat adoptions so far, we also helped place 5 rabbits and 4 guinea pigs. Our drive-through clinics have covered basic vaccinations for 201 dogs, 111 cats. And more than 30 cats have been fixed and returned to their caretakers. Additionally, we have provided food, some emergency vet care and other supplies for more than 75 pets.
